SECTION B: Event report and reflection

Anatomy and Physiology is one of the main courses for Nursing students in order to become licensed nurses in their state during their studying period that outlines the structure and function of the body which is mandatory for anyone who plans to work in the field of health care delivery to meet the needs of the patients. Nurses need Anatomy and Physiology to understand how to care for their patient. The body must remain in a balanced state to operate. When the body does not maintain balance, nurses must figure out how to restore the body's equilibrium to help the patient. Nurses must be able to think and act quickly when a patient needs care. The programme got commenced at 10.00 am with the Welcome speech by Ms.Richa Singh, II year M.Sc Nursing student, followed by welcoming address. Prof. Pauline Sharmila, Dean, SNSR shared her words of encouragement to the presenters and the participants. Afterwards, there was a session of pre-test (questionnaire containing 30 items) conducted to assess the knowledge about Anatomy and Physiology. Knowledge level 158 students were assessed. In the morning there were seminar sessions from 10.00 am to 1.00 pm and in the afternoon session there were workshop session in the Anatomy& Physiology Lab at SMSR, Sharda University and Video sessions and explanations were given in the afternoon in the same auditorium continuously for four days. There were poster competitions on the topis Heart, Eye, Uterus, Brain and Lungs in the ground floor of SNSR and it was evaluated by Prof.Pauline Sharmila, Principal, SNSR. At 12.00 to 1.00 pm we held a valedictory session of the seminar and workshop, during which, There was prize distribution ceremony of Anatomy and Physiology workshop and the Nurses week events. Chief guest of this session were Dr. Nirupma Gupta, (HOD, Anatomy department, SMSR) & amp; Mrs. Vandana wife of Hon'ble Pro-Chancellor and Prof. Pauline Sharmila, Principal, SNSR, Sharda University. All the stdent presenters were evaluated and best presenters were appreciated by presenting in the presenters and mementos.

there was a student participants feed back session. Student's feedback was found to be extremely good on the seminar and workshop. There was an announcement about the effectiveness of the seminar and workshop by comparison of pre-test and post-test scores. Hence it is concluded that the students knowledge has improved by this seminar and workshop held between 7 th and 10 th March 2017. Followed by the student's feedback, there held the prize distribution. Prizes along with the certificates were distributed for the best presenters (both seminar and workshop), best performers in chart making and anatomy test, best guides and organizers.






