More Indian Historical and Primary Text should be included in the syllabus

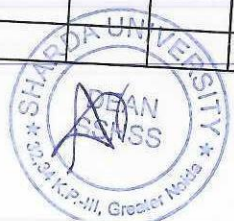
Courses on enhancement of employability need to be included.
